- The program is designed to build skills and discipline that will help you to succeed in an opera career.
- The program focuses on the standard operatic repertoire with emphasis on Italian repertoire.
- The opportunity to sing in an Opera and Sacred music concerts and a fully staged opera with a professional orchestra.
- Private singing and coaching lessons.
- Master classes with world-renowned professional opera singers, opera coaches, conductors and stage directors.
- Daily Italian lessons, diction lessons with native speaker teacher.
- Speech therapy and breathing lessons.
- Acting classes where you will work on the Opera that will be staged.
- Audition training seminar.
